
## Password Protection:

## The Foundation of Your Digital Safety

Many services we subscribe to – from music to video streaming services and social media – are equipped with some geolocation functionalities as added protection to our accounts... #### **Enhanced Password Safety Measures:**

- Create complex passwords using a mix of letters, numbers, and symbols.
- Never reuse passwords across different sites and apps and keep them private.
- Use two-factor authentication for an added layer of security.
- Change your password immediately if you've shared it with someone you've been dating, and are no longer in touch with.

#### Unmasking Too-Good-to-Be-True Profiles

Online dating profiles (or even social media profiles) can be fabricated to deceive, manipulate, or exploit...
Luring you into starting a conversation and learning more about you under false pretences. A great rule of thumb is that if it seems too good to be true, it probably is...

However, if in doubt there are checks you can make:

#### **Proactive Verification Techniques:**

- Run a reverse-image search for that profile... If it appears in multiple other pages under multiple names, it is most likely a cat-phisher.
- Look for inconsistencies in their stories or profile details.
- Be wary of sudden, intense expressions of love or requests for money.
- Use video calls to verify their identity before meeting in person.

### Crafting Your Digital Persona with Care

#### Gradual Trust Building: The Key to Sharing Personal Information

- Think twice before sharing emotionally charged or intimate content
- Set personal boundaries on the type of information you share early in a relationship; and only reveal personal details gradually as trust builds over time.
- Listen to your instincts—if something feels off, take a step back and give yourself a moment
